

# COVID – Extended Use

Extended Use refers to the practice of wearing the same N95 respirator for repeated close contact encounters with several patients, without removing the respirator between patient encounters.

## Eyes and Mask

**1**

**Exit patient room.**



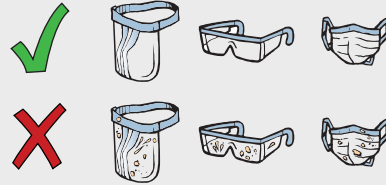
**2**

**Sanitize hands.**



**3**

Keep **eye protection** and **mask** on if they are not visibly soiled.



## Gown

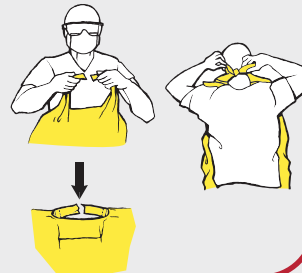
**4**

Get a new **gown**.



**5**

**Don't slip** gown over eye protection or mask. Tear the neck at center if necessary and then tie.



**6**

**Tie the gown** at the waist.



\*Gown can be reused in cohorts of positive patients ONLY. **Don't reuse** gowns between mixed patient populations (COVID positive and PUI patients).

## Entry

**8**

**Sanitize hands.**



**9**

**Put on clean gloves.**



**10**

**Enter NEXT patient room.**
